## UNSEASONAL DRYING TREND INCREASES FIRE DANGER

PARKSVILLE – Temperatures in the Coastal Fire Centre are continuing to break records and the current fire danger ratings are higher than normal for this time of the forest fire season. The fire danger rating is currently registering as 'high' (DC 4) or 'extreme' (DC 5) at many weather stations in the Coastal Fire Centre and with no significant precipitation in the forecast these ratings will continue to increase. This will result in restrictions as per Schedule 3 of the Wildfire Regulation when conducting high risk activities.

Caution must be exercised in any industrial operations particularly when working in fine forest fuels such as logging slash. With an increased potential for industrial fire starts due to this unseasonal increase in fire danger ratings, it would be prudent to ensure that your industrial operations, notably high risk activities, are monitored by a representative weather station. It is recommended that there is adequate fire fighting equipment and personnel on site to ensure compliance with the *Wildfire Act* and *Regulation*, which can be found at our web site at <a href="mailto:gov.bc.ca/wildfirelegislation">gov.bc.ca/wildfirelegislation</a>.

Please ensure that any open burns conducted this spring are patrolled to ensure they are extinguished. Details of your obligations can be found at our web site at <a href="mailto:gov.bc.ca/wildfiresindustry">gov.bc.ca/wildfiresindustry</a>. Effective noon Friday May 18, 2018, all Category 2 open burning will be prohibited in the Coastal Fire Centre with the exception of the Haida Gwaii Forest District and the Fog Zone.
